## **Available Awards and Important Information:**

# *Igniting the Future:*

The Lee County Black History Society will select one student to award a one-year *Igniting* the Future scholarship in the amount of **\$1,000** for the student to attend a College of his or her choice. (Students with a GPA of 3.9 and above are eligible)

## Igniting the Future Emerging Scholar:

The Lee County Black History Society will select one student to award a one-year *Igniting* the Future Emerging Scholar scholarship in the amount of **\$500** for the student to attend a College of his or her choice. (Students with a GPA of 2.5-3.8 are eligible).

- The application process for the scholarship begins April 24, 2024.
- The application submission deadline is May 19, 2024 @11:59pm
- The application and all supporting materials must be submitted by the deadline date
- Applications may be downloaded from the website at www.leecountyblackhistorysociety.org
- Applications will not be considered after the deadline date of May 19, 2024.
- The selection committee will notify all applicants via email of the notice of decision.
- The Scholarship Committee will invite the finalist to be recognized at our Juneteenth event on Saturday, June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2024. If the finalist is not available, please let us know immediately at blackhistory@leecountybhs.org

## **Eligibility Requirements**

- Two Scholarships:
  - o 3.9 cumulative GPA or higher. A copy of the applicant's most recent transcript must be submitted with the application.
  - o 2.5 cumulative GPA or higher. A copy of the applicant's most recent transcript must be submitted with the application.
- Must be a high school senior at the time of the application.
- Must be a resident of Lee County, graduating from a Lee County School.

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- Must demonstrate how the scholarship will assist the recipient in pursuing their degree (Explained in the essay- prompt)
- Must demonstrate evidence of good character achievements, and potential for education and career advancement by submitting two letters of recommendation. One letter from a school official (coach, teacher, staff member, etc.) and One letter from an employer, minister, youth group leader, community coach, or a non-relative who knows you well to speak of your character.

#### **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

- The scholarship awarded will be merit and/or need based.
- The recipient will be requested to provide a thank you photo image to share with the LCBHS and community-at-large.
- The recipient of the award will be given a year membership to LCBHS.
